



## 2025 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION GUIDELINES

### Quest Scholarship

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: Aug 23, 2025**

The **Baltimore County Alumnae Chapter (BCAC)** of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award a limited number of scholarships to academically meritorious students based upon available public service funds. Scholarship awards may range from Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) per academic year.

The BCAC **Quest Scholarship** is intended to assist adult Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC) students who are seeking an Associate Degree or Certification that will enhance their career and educational goals.

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Submission of a completed BCAC Scholarship Application in its entirety
- ✓ Acceptance into the Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC)
- ✓ Must be at least 18 years of age
- ✓ Must reside in Baltimore County, Maryland
- ✓ High School transcript with minimum GPA of 2.75 or GED/Certificate (if applicable)

#### APPLICATION PROCESS:

- ✓ Complete **on-line** scholarship application in its entirety, which includes:
  - Uploaded complete high school transcript of GED/Certificate
  - Uploaded letter of acceptance from CCBC
  - Uploaded two (2) letters of recommendation **on official letterhead with signature** from the list of people, **excluding relatives**, identified on the application form who have personally interacted with the applicant (e.g., school official, clergy, community leaders, employer) and can attest to the applicant's character and/or abilities.
  - Uploaded typed original essay (minimum 250 words) on one of the topics provided on the application form
  - Include applicant's full name at the top of supplemental documents.
- ✓ Retain a copy of the application materials for your records.

**SELECTION & NOTICE OF AWARD RECIPIENTS:** Selections will be based on the applicant's overall academic progress, leadership skills, and participation in community activities. BCAC will notify applicants of the results of the selection process in writing.

**REVOCATION OF AWARD:** BCAC reserves the right to revoke any scholarship award at any time if the applicant falsifies information or fails to meet or maintain academic standards.
