



2025 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Memorial Scholarship

APPLICATION DEADLINE: APRIL 15, 2025

The **Baltimore County Alumnae Chapter (BCAC)** of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award a limited number of scholarships to academically meritorious students based upon available public service funds. Scholarship awards may range from Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) per academic year.

The BCAC **Memorial Scholarship** was established to commemorate the lives of BCAC members who made significant contributions to the community. This scholarship is intended to help supplement one (1) year of expenses incurred while a registered student attends a college or university.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Submission of a completed BCAC Scholarship Application in its entirety
- ✓ Acceptance into an accredited four-year college or university for one academic year
- ✓ 2025 high school graduate (expected)
- ✓ Reside and/or attend a school in Baltimore County, Maryland

APPLICATION PROCESS

- ✓ Complete **on-line** scholarship application in its entirety, which includes:
 - Uploaded complete high school transcript
 - Uploaded letter(s) of acceptance from an accredited four-year college or university
 - Uploaded three (3) letters of recommendation **on official letterhead with signature** from the list of persons, **excluding relatives**, identified on the application form who have personally interacted with the applicant (e.g., through supervision, instruction, and/or coaching) and can attest to the applicant's character and/or abilities.
 - Uploaded typed essay (500 -750 words) on one of the topics provided on the application form
 - Include applicant's full name at the top of supplemental documents.
 - Note: Inclusion of SAT and/or ACT scores are **optional**. If scores are provided, bonus points may be applicable.
- ✓ Retain a copy of application materials for your records.

SELECTION & NOTICE OF AWARD RECIPIENTS: Selections will be based on the applicant's overall academic progress, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, and participation in community activities. BCAC will notify applicants of the results of the selection process in writing.

REVOCAION OF AWARD: BCAC reserves the right to revoke any scholarship award at any time if the applicant falsifies information or fails to meet or maintain academic standards.
